



## PAKENHAM SECONDARY COLLEGE UNIFORM POLICY

### **RATIONALE:**

All students are required to wear full uniform as agreed to on enrolment at the College. It promotes a sense of identity with the College and places all students on an equal footing.

A number of items are regulation, meaning that the style, fabric or manufacture, has been determined by the College Council. The main uniform supplier is the Pakenham Secondary College Uniform Shop.

### **IMPLEMENTATION:**

#### **BOYS:**

Shorts	Summer, Grey tailored regulation style
Trousers	Winter, Grey tailored regulation style
Shirt	Green polo shirt long/short sleeve regulation style or plain white long or short sleeved business style shirt with logo
Jumper	Black College jumper or black fleece polo top with logo
Socks	Grey or black with trousers. Plain white with shorts
Shoes	Plain black, polishable leather, lace up or buckle – no stripes, logos, etc.

#### **GIRLS:**

Dress	Summer, Regulation style
Shorts	Summer, Tailored regulation style black shorts (knee length)
Skirt	Winter, Green and grey check regulation style
Trousers	Winter, Black regulation style, traditional and wide leg
Shirt	Green polo shirt long/short sleeve regulation style or plain white long or short sleeved business style shirt (for girls) with logo
Socks	Black with trousers, Long black socks or stockings with skirt Plain white with Dress and Shorts.
Shoes	Plain black, leather, lace up with plain black laces or buckle- no stripes, logos, etc.

#### **PHYSICAL & SPORT EDUCATION**

Shirt	Gold polo regulation style
Shorts	Black, no pockets
Socks	Plain white
Shoes	Runners
Tracksuit	Black ( optional )

## **GENERAL ITEMS**

Jumper	Black College regulation Style or black fleece polo top with Logo
Jacket	College regulation style
Hat	Plain hats in accordance with sun smart policy
Scarf	Black
Gloves	Black

Only plain white t shirts can be worn under the uniform.

## **HAIRSTYLES AND HAIR COLOURS**

Hairstyles and hair colors considered to be extreme in color, length or style are not acceptable and could result in the child being sent home. Students with hair that is dyed should have a color that resembles a natural hair colour.

## **JEWELLERY/PIERCINGS**

All jewellery needs to be discrete and earrings should be sleepers or studs. All other piercings should be transparent. Visible / non transparent body piercing is not permitted at school.

## **UNIFORM PASS**

If a student is out of uniform they need to bring a note from their parent or guardian explaining why they are out of uniform. This note should be given to the team leader or educator before the start of the day where they will receive a uniform pass for the day. Students who are out of uniform without a pass or fail to provide an acceptable reason for being out of uniform will be required to do an after school detention
